Respected Sir, Madam,

In continuation of the mail sent you on 29th December, 2023 and the interaction meeting held online on 2nd January 2024 which was attended by 27 College principals and their representatives/college CES nodal person, I am providing the following for your kind cooperation in conducting admission under CES 2023-24 (II & IV semester) on priority basis.

1. Admission under CES 2023-24 (II & IV semester) is open to two categories of candidates i.e. a) senior citizen, b) Non-senior citizen. This scheme has the primary objective to provide opportunities for those individuals who have already left the educational institutions, retired officials, working/studying in other institutions. Under CES, one eligible student shall have the opportunity to study a maximum of 2 papers in one semester offered by different departments of colleges. They would be required to attend classes along with the existing regular students in their classrooms. All the rules applied for regular students shall be the same for the CES students after induction in the respective colleges.

The maximum number of students in each paper shall be 6 or 10% of the class strength, whichever is minimum.

3. The admission under this scheme shall be for one semester (to study a maximum of two papers for a maximum of 8 credits to be transferred in the Academic Bank of Credit of the student [if applicable]). Fee of Rs. 10000 shall be paid by the CES student for only one semester (this covers either a candidate opts 1 or 2 papers). If any CES student fails in the overall assessment (as applicable to regular student), then he/she shall not be eligible to appear for re-examination/revaluation/improvement; however if he/she desires, can apply for readmission in any paper (offered by any department of any college) by following all the procedures of admission in the forthcoming semester. No preference to the Ex CES student is applicable.

4. The admission eligibility based on the academic score, and age of the candidate shall be examined and screened by ILL. The application for the course shall be done online and announcing the final list of eligible students for admission for each college shall be done by the ILL, University of Delhi in collaboration with DUCC.

5. As of now, the colleges are not required to adjust their time table for CES students; it is the CES student who has to manage to attend classes as per the existing table applicable to the regular students in the respective colleges.

6. Once the ILL recommends students for admission to respective colleges under CES; the admission of CES students, their induction in the classroom, conduct of internal and final exams shall be the responsibility of the respective colleges.

7. Each college is expected to offer minimum 2 papers and maximum (2 papers from each discipline/department/subject) as per its resource availability in terms of infrastructure and teaching strength. No additional workload or any assistance shall be provided to the colleges in this regard.

8. The selection of papers (from programs/courses) is the discretion of each subject/discipline department under the guidance of the head of the institution/principal. In case, if a paper is of multidisciplinary nature then, it shall be counted as a paper of that department which is responsible to teach the paper in the respective colleges.

9. Colleges are required to submit the details of maximum two papers from one department choosing any of the following ways:

- (a) 1 paper from semester II and 1 paper from semester IV
- (b) 2 papers from semester II
- (c) 2 Papers from Semester IV

[For example- If a college has 10 departments (such as history, sociology, Mathematic.....etc). Then minimum 2 papers (from any 1 or 2 departments) can be offered and maximum 20 papers (i.e. 2 papers from each department) can be offered] Please provide the details of papers offered by departments of your college in the following Google Link: <https://forms.gle/rCnNk42482BDNHvN7>
