Sub:- Amendment/Addition in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board-reg.

Sir/Madam,

Consequent upon approval of the Affiliation Committee Meeting held on 14.01.2013 and subsequently ratified by the Governing Body of the Board in its Meeting held on 22.01.2013, I am directed to inform that the following amendments/additions in affiliation bye-laws of the Board have been made by the Board with the following modification:-

School having enrolment of less than 300 students in classes from IX to XII can appoint a Health Wellness Teacher on a part time basis.

The following provisions have been added in Appendix-II of the Affiliation Bye-Laws to be made effective in all such cases to be dealt w.e.f. 01.04.2013.

The following provisions have been made by incorporating additional rule 15.1 (d) with minor amendment in its Affiliation Bye-Laws.

15.1 (d) "The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the Middle Classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books from private publishers. The content must be scrutinized to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group or society. If found prescribing books having such content, the school will have to take the responsibility of such content."

Provided the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with a written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the Principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.


All the Heads of Institutions are directed to abide by the Provisions of amended/additional Rules in the functioning of school henceforth.
