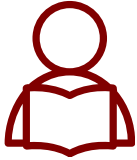

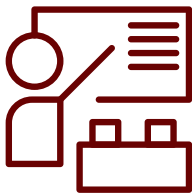

The University of Delhi is a premier University of the Country with a venerable legacy and international acclaim for the highest academic standards, diverse educational programs, distinguished faculty, illustrious alumni, varied co-curricular activities and modern infrastructure. Over the many years of its existence, the University has sustained the highest Global standards and best practices in higher education. Its long-term commitment to nation-building and unflinching adherence to universal human values are reflected in its motto: 'Nishtha Dhriti Satyam' निष्ठा धृतिः सत्यम् (Dedication, Steadfastness and Truth).

Established in 1922 as a unitary, teaching and residential University by the Act of the then Central Legislative Assembly, a strong commitment to excellence in teaching, research and social outreach has made the University a role model and trendsetter for other Universities.

The President of India is the Visitor, the Vice-President is the Chancellor and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of India is the Pro-Chancellor of the University. Beginning with three colleges and 750 students, it has grown into one of the largest universities in India with 16 faculties, 86 academic departments, 91 colleges and over seven lakh students. A total of 540 programs offered by the University are approved by Academic and Executive Councils.

Undergraduate Curriculum Framework

UGCF – 2022

The UGCF - 2022 underlines the historical perspective, philosophical basis, and contemporary realities of higher education as enshrined in the National Education Policy (NEP – 2020) and endeavors to synchronize these cornerstones while charting the road ahead for the state of higher education.

The University of Delhi, a premier seat of teaching, learning, and research in higher education, acclaimed nationally and internationally, has nurtured the quest for reaching the peak in every sphere of education, in its true sense, in its contribution to the nation-building. Moreover, being a Central University mandated to act as the torch bearer in expanding the horizons of human resource development through the expansion of higher education, it has always paid an adequate premium towards constructive and meaningful innovation as a regular feature in its undergraduate curriculum development over the years.

A reflection of such sustained and continued endeavour is amply exemplified in the successive revision of undergraduate curricular framework over the decades, keeping pace with the emerging trends in higher education in the new millennium globally and its critical importance in enriching the youth of our nation, well equipped with the prevailing priorities of skill development through innovative and practical oriented teaching-learning more than anything else.

To actualize the noble objective, as succinctly brought out in the NEP - 2020, the University of Delhi has endeavored to explore the possibility of further restructuring and refinement of its undergraduate curriculum framework in line with the objective and underlying philosophy of the NEP - 2020 to capture the imagination of the youth of our nation which depicts the contemporary realities of our demographic advantage globally.

The resultant outcome of this comprehensive exercise undertaken by the University of Delhi is the UGCF - 2022 which not only underlines the hearth and soul of the NEP - 2020 in letter and spirit but also goes on to create a teaching-learning framework at the undergraduate level to attract the young minds towards research, innovation, apprenticeship, social outreach, entrepreneurship and similar such areas of human knowledge and endeavour while imbibing the truly charged academic environment of the University of Delhi and its constituent Colleges.

Registrations and Admission to Undergraduate Programs

1 REGULAR STUDENTS

The candidate must be a citizen of India.

For admission to Undergraduate Programs at University of Delhi, all candidates (including those applying under supernumerary quota) must register for CUET (UG)-2024 at <http://cuetug.ntaonline.in>

For seat allocations and admissions, candidates must apply to the Common Seat Allocation System (CSAS(UG)-2024) of University of Delhi. Details related to allocations and admissions through CSAS(UG)-2024 etc. will be notified separately. Candidate must visit www.admission.uod.ac.in on regular basis.

2 SCHOOL OF OPEN LEARNING (SOL)

Candidates desirous of taking admission in SOL must register at www.sol.du.ac.in and visit the website on regular basis.

3 NON-COLLEGIATE WOMEN EDUCATION BOARD (NCWEB)

Candidates desirous of taking admission in NCWEB must register at University of Delhi. For details refer to ncwebadmission.uod.ac.in on regular basis.

4 FOREIGN NATIONALS

10% of Supernumerary seats in each Program are reserved for Foreign Nationals. Candidates seeking admission under the Foreign Students' category are required to apply on Foreign Students' registry website at fsr.du.ac.in

Important Points

1. Admissions to all Undergraduate Programs at the University of Delhi will be based on the scores obtained in CUET (UG) - 2024, except for admissions to the School of Open Learning (SOL), Non-Collegiate Women Education Board (NCWEB) and for Foreign Nationals.
2. An eligible candidate desirous of seeking admission to the Undergraduate Program(s) of the University of Delhi for the academic session 2024-25 must read the contents of this Bulletin of Information (BOI) 2024-25, as well as the notifications, updates and information published on the admission website of the University of Delhi very carefully.
3. The candidate must have studied and passed Class XII examination or its equivalent from a single recognized board.
4. The candidate must have studied and passed Class XII examination of any Board / university in India, or any foreign country recognized as equivalent to the 10+2 system by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU).
5. **For admission to University of Delhi, it is mandatory for the candidate to appear in CUET (UG) - 2024 in those subjects in which s(he) is appearing/has passed Class XII.**
6. In case the subject studied at Class XII is not mentioned in the CUET (UG) - 2024, the candidate must appear in the Language/Domain Specific subject that is similar/closely related to the subject s(he) has studied at Class XII (for example, if a candidate has studied Biochemistry in Class XII, s(he) must appear in Biology in CUET (UG) - 2024). For establishing similarity of CUET (UG) subjects with subjects taken in Class XII, at least 50% of the syllabus of should match. The University reserves the right for establishing the similarity. The decision of University in this regard shall be final and binding.
7. Allocation and admission will be based only on the combination of Language, Domain Specific subjects and/or General Test in which a candidate has appeared in CUET (UG) – 2024 as per the respective Program-Specific Eligibility.
8. Only the scores obtained in CUET (UG) - 2024 will be considered for admissions to the academic year 2024-25.
9. The candidate must read the Program-Specific requirements carefully and then appear in Language and/ or Domain Specific Subjects of the CUET (UG) - 2024.
10. The candidate is advised to check that s(he) satisfies all eligibility criteria for the Program(s) for which s(he) is appearing in CUET (UG) - 2024. Admission is subject to the candidate fulfilling the eligibility requirements prescribed for applying to the concerned program of study. In case a candidate does not meet any eligibility criteria prescribed for applying to the concerned program and appears in the entrance test, it is at the candidate's own risk and cost. If at any stage, it is found that eligibility requirements are not fulfilled, the admission, if granted, shall be cancelled *ipso facto*.

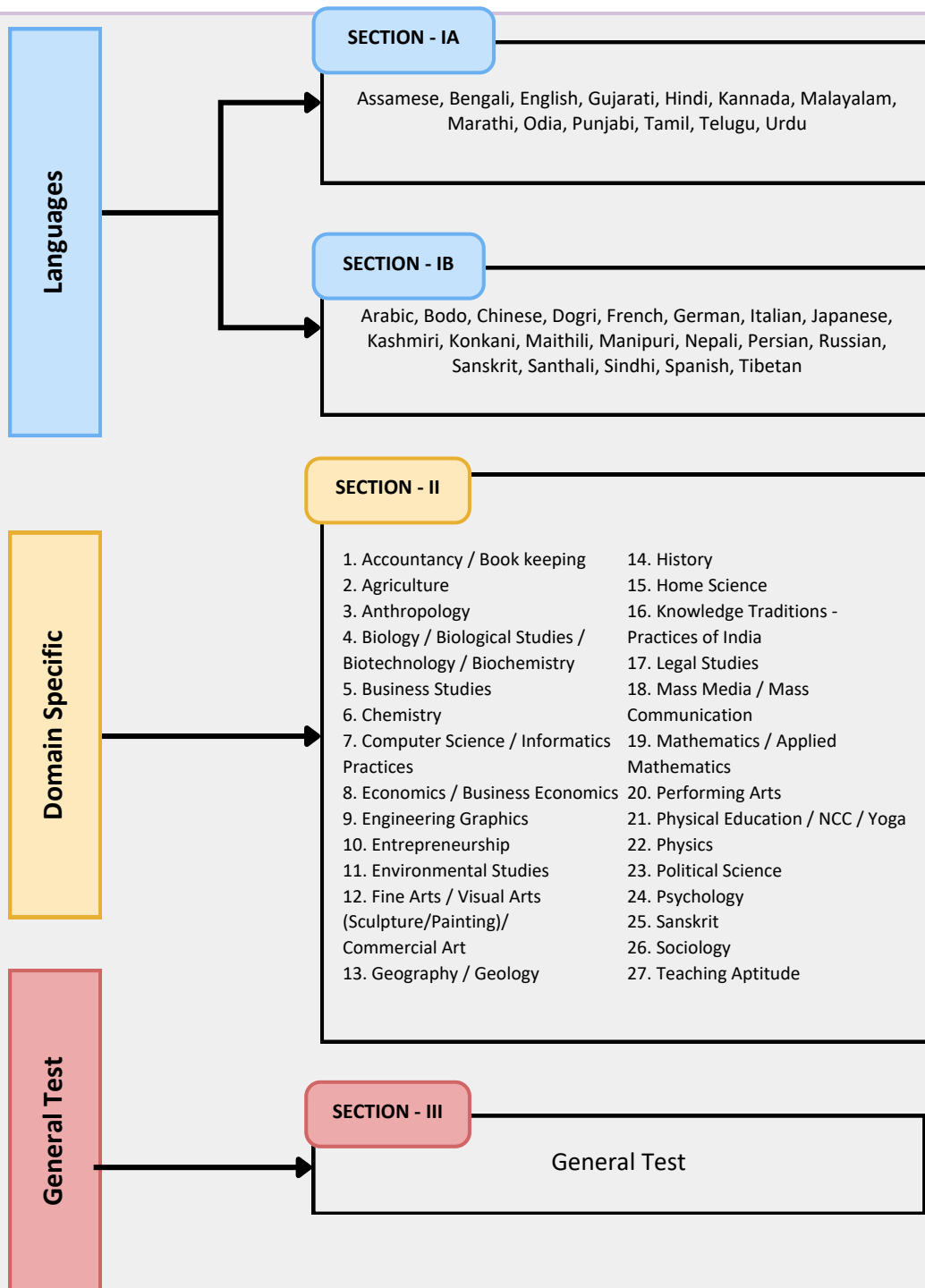
11. Grievance related to non-appearance in CUET (UG) - 2024 or the required Language, Domain Specific subjects and/or General Test will not be entertained.
12. Before registering for CUET (UG) - 2024, the candidate is advised to carefully read the Bulletin of Information (BOI) 2024-25 and consult the University of Delhi Act, 1922 and the Statutes. The Ordinances, Rules and Regulations of the University of Delhi, available on the University website, would be binding on them.
13. Candidates must be careful while filling the CUET (UG)-2024 form as certain fields such as Name, signature and photograph of the candidate will be later auto-integrated by University of Delhi from CUET (UG)-2024. These fields will be non-editable.
14. The name of the candidate claiming reservation must match with the Candidate's name as it appears on their corresponding School Board qualifying certificates and in CUET (UG)-2024. Similarly, the parents' names must also match in the certificates.
15. As per Ordinance-I of University of Delhi, there is no minimum age bar for admission to the undergraduate programs in the University and its colleges except in the programs where the respective regulatory bodies, such as Medical Council of India (MCI), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Bar Council of India (BCI), National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), Dental Council of India (DCI), etc. have prescribed the minimum age requirement in their regulations.
16. Gap year will not be a bar for purpose of admission to undergraduate programs. However, such candidates must also appear in CUET (UG) - 2024 for admissions in academic year 2024-25.
17. Appropriate proration in CUET (UG) - 2024 scores will be done wherever required (including supernumerary quota).

Eligibility Requirement for Undergraduate Admissions

Common Minimum Eligibility

The candidate must have passed the Class XII or its equivalent examination from a single recognized board.

For the purpose of ascertaining the Minimum Eligibility, the marksheet/ degree of only one board will be considered. (For example, if a candidate has appeared in CBSE Board Examination with five subjects except for Mathematics and later appears and passes Mathematics from another board such as the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS), the minimum eligibility shall be ascertained from his/her mark sheet issued by CBSE only).

Program Specific Eligibilities

Candidate must refer to the Program-Specific Eligibility to choose the subjects in which s(he) should appear in CUET (UG) – 2024.

It is mandatory for the candidates to appear in CUET(UG)-2024 in those subjects in which s(he) is appearing/ has passed Class XII. For the purpose of ascertaining Program Specific Eligibility and for mapping the CUET subject(s) with Class XII subject(s), marksheet of more than one recognized board may be considered provided the candidate has passed those subjects in Class XII.

Collaborate with others, including multidisciplinary groups, to solve scientific problems and recognize ethical issues in each profession; logical question assertions and recognizing patterns are other highlights of the course.

Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:

This will enable students to provide necessary feedback in the related area of investigation. The students are provided with various choices in the skill enhancement course directly related to implementing knowledge in society. This program creates a strong foundation for all forms of teachers training courses in physical education & sports sciences at various levels.

RESERVATION POLICIES

Reservation of Seats for scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) Candidates

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

22.5% of the total numbers of seats is reserved for Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (15% for Scheduled Caste and 7.5% for Scheduled Tribes, interchangeable if necessary).

The Candidate must be in possession of the Caste/Tribe certificate in his/her own name at the time of Registration and Admission. The Caste certificate should clearly state:

- (a) Name of his/her caste/tribe
- (b) Whether candidate belongs to SC or ST
- (c) District and the State or Union Territory of Candidate's usual place of residence, and
- (d) the appropriate Govt. of India Schedule under which his / her caste / tribe is approved as SC or ST.

Candidate will have to produce the valid original SC or ST certificate at the time of admission.

The following are empowered to issue the requisite SC / ST certificate:

- a. District Magistrate / Additional District Magistrate / Collector / Deputy Commissioner / Addl. Deputy Commissioner / Deputy Collector / 1st class Stipendiary Magistrate / City Magistrate / Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate / Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- b. Chief Presidency Magistrate / Addl. Chief Presidency Magistrate / Presidency Magistrate.
- c. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- d. Sub- Divisional Officer of the area where the Candidate and/ or his family normally resides.
- e. Administrator / Secretary to the Administrator/ Development Officer (Lakshadweep Islands).

Candidates to note that the SC / ST Certificate from any other person / authority shall not be accepted in any case. If the Candidate happens to belong to SC or ST, Candidate's caste / tribe must be listed in the appropriate Govt. of India Schedule.

It is a statutory obligation on the part of Colleges to fill all seats reserved for Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe Candidates.

Colleges shall not refuse admission to any SC / ST Candidate on the basis of medium of instruction. Any deficiency in the knowledge of any particular language should be addressed; for this purpose remedial classes may be arranged by the College by utilizing grants available from University Grants Commission.

Reservation of Seats for Other Backward Classes (OBC-NCL, Central List)

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the Other Backward Classes (OBC-Non Creamy Layer) must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

27% seats are reserved for the Candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes (OBC -Non-Creamy Layer, Central List).

At the time of giving admission to an OBC Candidate, the College will ensure that the caste is included in the Central List of OBC (the OBC status is to be determined on the basis of the Central (Govt. of India) List of OBCs notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward Classes (available at the website http://ncbc.nic.in/backward_classes/index.html).

The certificate must mention non-creamy layer status of the Candidate (Non-creamy layer status issued by an authority mentioned in DOPT Office Memorandum no. 36012/22/93- Estt. (SCT) dated 15.11.1993).

The OBC Candidates who belong to the 'Non-Creamy Layer' and **whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs only**, shall be eligible to be considered for admission under the OBC category (Validity period of OBC certificate in respect of 'non-creamy layer' status of the Candidates as per DOPT Office Memorandum No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res- I) dated 31 March 2016). The certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2024.

It is a statutory obligation on the part of Colleges to fill all the seats reserved for OBC -NCL Candidates.

Reservation policy for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

As per the University of Delhi notifications (Reference No. Aca. I / Reservation of EWSs / 2019/ 63 Dated 28th March 2019 and Reference No. Aca. I / Reservation of EWSs / 2019 / 101 Dated 15th May 2019), for the reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) Category, the University Departments / Centres / Colleges have reserved 10% seats for admission of candidates belonging to EWS category. The certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2024.

Admission on Supernumerary Quota

Admission to all supernumerary quota seats will be through CUET (UG) - 2024. Candidates desirous of taking admission on Supernumerary seats must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)

Five percent (5%) of the total sanctioned strength in each Program are reserved for PwBD candidates.

Separate Allocation result/s will be declared for candidates seeking admission under PwBD quota.

For the format of PwBD certificate, refer to Admission website www.admission.uod.ac.in. Disability Certificates issued after 01.06.2021 must be as per the Gazette Notification no. 1736 (E) dated 05.05.2021 issued by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities and applied through UDID portal. However, Disability Certificates issued before 01.06.2021, will be considered as per other existing applicable rules and notifications of the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities and the University of Delhi.

As per the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, a 'person with benchmark disability means a person with not less than forty percent (40%) of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority'. It may be noted that the erstwhile Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protect of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (No. 1 of 1996), under which reservation for Persons with Disabilities in admissions was provided earlier has now been repealed.

Person with benchmark disabilities falling within any of the following specified categories of disabilities as mentioned in the Schedule to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 [See Clause (zc) of Section 2 of the said Act] are eligible to get the benefit of the said reservation.

A. Locomotor Disability

Locomotor disability (a person's inability to execute distinctive activities associated with movement of self and objects resulting from affliction of musculoskeletal or nervous system or both), including—

1. **"Leprosy cured person"** means a person who has been cured of leprosy but is suffering from—
 - i) loss of sensation in hands or feet as well as loss of sensation and paresis in the eye and eye-lid but with no manifestation of deformity;

- ii) manifest deformity and paresis but having sufficient mobility in their hands and feet to enable them to engage in normal economic activity;
 - iii) extreme physical deformity as well as advanced age which prevents him/her from undertaking any gainful occupation, and the expression "leprosy cured" shall construed accordingly;
2. **"Cerebral palsy"** means a Group of non-progressive neurological condition affecting body movements and muscle coordination, caused by damage to one or more specific areas of the brain, usually occurring before, during or shortly after birth;
 3. **"Dwarfism"** means a medical or genetic condition resulting in an adult height of 4feet 10 inches (147 centimeters) or less;
 4. **"Muscular Dystrophy"** means a group of hereditary genetic muscle disease that weakens the muscles that move the human body and persons with multiple dystrophy have incorrect and missing information in their genes, which prevents them from making the proteins they need for healthy muscles. It is characterized by progressive skeletal muscle weakness, defects in muscle proteins, and the death of muscle cells and tissue;
 5. **"Acid Attack Victims"** means a person disfigured due to violent assaults by throwing of acid or similar corrosive substance.

B. Visual impairment

6. **"Blindness"** means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, after best correction
 - i) total absence of sight; or
 - ii) visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible correction;or
 - iii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degree.
7. **"Low-Vision"** means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, namely:
 - i) visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 or less than 20/60 upto 3/60 or upto 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eyewith best possible corrections; or
 - ii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 40 degree upto 10 degree.

C. Hearing Impairment

8. **"Deaf"** means persons having 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;
9. **"Hard of Hearing"** means person having 60 DB to 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;
10. **"Speech and Language Disability"** means a permanent disability arising out of conditions such as laryngectomy or aphasia affecting one or more components of speech and language due to organic orneurological causes.

D. Intellectual Disability

A condition characterised by significant limitation both in intellectual functioning (reasoning, learning, problem solving) and in adaptive behaviour which covers a range of every day, social and practical skills, including—

11. **"Specific Learning Disabilities"** means a heterogeneous group of conditions wherein there is a deficit in processing language, spoken or written, that may manifest itself as a difficulty to comprehend, speak, read, write, spell, or to do mathematical calculations and includes such conditions as perceptual disabilities, dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, dyspraxia and developmental aphasia;
12. **"Autism Spectrum Disorder"** means a neuro-developmental condition typically appearing in the first three years of life that significantly affects a person's ability to communicate, understand relationships and relate to others, and is frequently associated with unusual or stereotypical rituals or behaviours.

E. Mental Illness

"Mental illness" means a substantial disorder of thinking, mood, perception, orientation or memory that grossly impairs judgment, behaviour, capacity to recognise reality or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life, but does not include retardation which is a condition of arrested or incomplete development of mind of a person, specially characterised by subnormality of intelligence.

F. Disability caused due to Chronic neurological conditions, such as—

13. **"Multiple Sclerosis"** means an inflammatory, nervous system disease in which the myelin sheaths around the axons of nerve cells of the brain and spinal cord are damaged, leading to demyelination and affecting the ability of nerve cells in the brain and spinal cord to communicate with each other;
14. **"Parkinson's Disease"** means a progressive disease of the nervous system marked by tremor, muscular rigidity, and slow, imprecise movement, chiefly affecting middle-aged and elderly people associated with degeneration of the basal ganglia of the brain and a deficiency of the neurotransmitter dopamine.

G. Blood Disorder

15. **"Haemophilia"** means an inheritable disease, usually affecting only male but transmitted by women to their male children, characterised by loss or impairment of the normal clotting ability of blood so that a minor wound may result in fatal bleeding.
16. **"Thalassemia"** means a group of inherited disorders characterised by reduced or absent amounts of haemoglobin.
17. **"Sickle Cell Disease"** means a haemolytic disorder characterised by chronic anaemia, painful events, and various complications due to associated tissue and organ damage; "haemolytic" refers to the destruction of the cell membrane of red blood cells resulting in the release of haemoglobin.

H. Multiple Disabilities (more than one of the above specified disabilities)

Multiple disabilities including deaf blindness which means a condition in which a person may have combination of hearing and visual impairments causing severe communication, developmental, and educational problems.

I. Any other category as may be notified by the Central Government.

Concessional/Waiver of fees in respect of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)

- a. Candidates with physical disabilities pursuing various programs of study in the Faculties, Departments, Centres, and Institutions / Colleges of the University shall be **exempted from payment of fees, including examination fee and other University fees**, except Admission fee, subscription towards Delhi University students' Union and Identity Card fee(As per amendment to Ordinance X(4) of the University).
- b. PwBD Candidates who meet the merit for the Unreserved category/SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS and takes admission in any of these categories will pay the fee relevant for a PwBD Candidate.
- c. As per the Executive Council Resolution No. 50 dated 03.11.2012, students with physical disabilities residing in different Hostels / Halls of the University are **exempted from payment of all hostel fees and charges** except refundable caution fee and the mess fees. Persons with Physical Disabilities who are students shall pay 50% of the Mess fee and the remaining **50% of their Mess Fee** will be met by the University of Delhi. **Similar norms are to be adopted by the Colleges in respect of PwBD Students residing in various hostels of the Colleges.**
- d. PwBD students who are getting fellowships / financial assistance shall be exempted from payment of fees / charges / mess fees subject to the following conditions.

Candidates must ensure that the PwBD certificate is in the name of the candidate and issued by a recognized Government Hospital, bearing duly attested photograph of the candidate.

Children/Widows of Personnel of the Armed Forces (CW)

Five percent (5%) of seats are reserved for Candidates under this category, program-wise in all colleges.

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the CW quota of the University must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

All such Candidates have to upload the Educational Concession Certificate (ECC) issued by **any of the following authorities** on the proper letterhead:

- (a) Secretary, Kendriya Sainik Board, Delhi.
- (b) Secretary, Rajya Zila Sainik Board.
- (c) Officer-in-Charge, Record Office.
- (d) 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate.
- (e) Ministry of Home Affairs (For Police Personnel in receipt of Gallantry Awards)

No other format shall be permissible. Proofs of the CW category in the form of ID card of parent or dependent, Medical card, Ration card, CSD card, etc. are not admissible in lieu of certificate in correct format. The priority must be clearly mentioned in the certificate. Certificates that do not mention the relevant priority will not be considered*.

Admission may be offered to the Children/Widows of Personnel of the Armed Forces (**Priority I to IX**) including Para-Military Personnel (**only Priority I to V**), in the following order of preference:

Priority I	Widows/Wards of Defence personnel killed in action;
Priority II	Wards of Defence Personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service with disability attributable to military service;
Priority III	Widows/Wards of Defence Personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service;
Priority IV	Wards of Defence Personnel disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service;
Priority V	Wards of Ex-servicemen and Serving personnel, including personnel of police forces who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i) Param Vir Chakra ii) Ashok Chakra iii) Maha Vir Chakra iv) Kirti Chakra v) Vir Chakra vi) Shaurya Chakra vii) President's Police Medal for Gallantry/President Gallantry Medal for the fire services personnel viii) Sena Medal (Gallantry), Nau Sena Medal (Gallantry), Vayu Sena Medal (Gallantry), Tatrakshak Medal (Gallantry) ix) Mention-in-Despatches x) Police Medal for Gallantry/Gallantry Medal for fire services

Kashmiri Migrants (KM)

Up to 5% seats are reserved program-wise in all colleges for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants. All the wards of Kashmiri Migrants will have to upload a certificate of registration as Kashmiri Migrants issued by Divisional Commissioner/Relief Commissioner.

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the Kashmiri Migrants quota must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme for J&K students (PMSSS)

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme for J&K students must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

Nomination of Seats for Sikkimese Students (SS)

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the Sikkim nomination scheme must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

Sikkimese students nominated by the Govt. of Sikkim shall be considered for admission by the University in Colleges where hostel facilities are available (AC Resolutions 51 dated 05/06/1980 and 122 dated 17/12/1990). The allocation of Sikkimese students for admission as well as for hostel accommodation in respective colleges be made by the Vice-Chancellor at his discretion.

Ward Quota of Employees of University of Delhi (WQ)

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the Ward Quota of Employees of University of Delhi must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

Admission to the wards of University and its College employees, both teaching and non-teaching will be done as per Academic Council resolution 9 a & b dated 27.11.2020 and subsequent amendments thereof.

Candidates must be in possession of a valid Employment Certificate issued by due officials at the time of registration. Only the Employment certificate uploaded at the time of registration will be considered. I-cards, Aadhar Card and/or any other document will not be accepted.

Admissions under ward quota for each college will be determined in three Program Clusters namely viz. Humanities, Commerce and Sciences. The allocation will also depend upon the number of Programs offered in a College/Department. Allocation of Ward Quota will be based on merit scores of candidates in program clusters and the order of preferences given by the candidates. The seats under ward quota allocated for teaching and non-teaching will not be interchangeable. However, allocations may be considered within the Program Clusters to maximize the benefit. Appropriate proration in CUET scores may be done to ascertain cluster-based merit.

Orphans Quota (OQ)

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the supernumerary Quota for Orphans must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

The University of Delhi will be admitting two candidates (one male and one female) in each program of study, both at the Undergraduate and Postgraduate level, . These two seats will be supernumerary. The Council of the University further resolved that the expenditure incurred for admission and continuance of study of such students in the University or its Colleges shall be met from the University Welfare Fund or College Students' Welfare Fund, as the case may be, for admissions in the University or in the College.

A candidate who wishes to seek admission under the orphans quota must possess a certificate from a Govt. recognized Orphanage/Charitable Home or Death certificate of both the parents.

As per University Notification No. Acad.I/Orphan Quota/2024-25/10 dated 16th January, 2024 -

1. Candidates seeking admission with effect from the Academic Session 2024-25 onwards under the Orphan Quota shall pay the following fees:-

- i. Admission Fee - Rs. 10.00
- ii. Examination Fee - Rs. 10.00
- iii. Hostel Fee - Rs. 10.00

2. Students availing hostel accommodation shall pay Mess Fees as per actuals.

Extra-Curricular Activities (ECA) and Sports Quota

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the supernumerary quota for ECA and/or Sports must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

For admissions to ECA and Sports supernumerary seats a weightage of 25% will be given to CUET score and 75% to certificates/trials/performances.

Admission in Minority Colleges

Candidates desirous of taking admission under Minority quota must appear in CUET (UG) - 2024.

In Minority Colleges 50% of the seats are for candidates belonging to the Unreserved category and 50% are reserved for Minority candidates.

Candidates belonging to Minority category must produce the certificate of minority at the time of admission containing details of the Minority Status of the candidate issued by any Government Organization/Local Municipality/ Panchayat/ Education Board/ School Leaving Certificate, etc or as applicable, issued by DSGMC/DMC or Baptism Certificate and/or Church membership certificate.

With respect to the issuance of minority certificate for Sikh candidates, the following may be noted:

(a) The agencies authorized to issue Sikh minority certificates i.e., Government organization/ local municipality/Panchayat/education board/ school leaving certificate etc., or as applicable should have requisite permission/approval/authorization from the respective government under whose jurisdiction they work for issuing of Sikh minority certificate.

(b) Definition/parameters of Sikh as defined in Sikh *Rehat Maryada* issued by Delhi Sikh Gurudwara Management Committee must be mentioned in the certificate.

Detailed information related to allocation of seats and admissions in the University will be published in the Common Seat Allocation System (Undergraduate)-2024 (CSAS (UG) - 2024).

Candidates must refer to the website of the University for CSAS(UG)-2024 and other related details.

Admission in SOL (DDCE) & NCWEB

School of Open Learning (Department of Distance and Continuing Education)

Under the ambit of University of Delhi, School of Open Learning (Department of Distance and Continuing Education), imparts quality higher education through distance mode. School of Open Learning (SOL) offers admission to various Undergraduate programs.

Admission in Undergraduate programs in SOL are based on the merit score obtained in Class XII.

For detailed information and updates on eligibility, program structure, admission procedures, fee structure and dates of admission, candidates are advised to visit sol.du.ac.in on regular basis.

Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board

Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB) which is a constituent part of University of Delhi, has been contributing towards empowerment of women through education since 1944. NCWEB offers two Undergraduate programs namely B.A. Program and B.Com.

Admission in above programs are based on the merit score obtained in Class XII.
