Dear Vice-Chancellor/Registrar

Indian Association of Parliamentarians on Population and Development (IAPPD), a 46 years old national autonomous non-profitable organization founded by Late Shri Satpaul Mittalji, MP, for the people's elected representatives from Panchayat to Parliament irrespective of their party affiliations, is now actively working under the Chairmanship of Prof. P.J. Kurien, Former Deputy Chairman, Rajya Sabha, in the field of population stabilization programmes, in co-operation with Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (GoI)/UNFPA/UNICEF and other UN Agencies.

Over the years IAPPD has grown into a vibrant institution-providing forum for the increasing involvement of Parliamentarians/ legislators/PRI elected people and local civic bodies. In order to sustain their interest in the population and development activities, the IAPPD from time to time organizes orientations, workshops, seminars, meetings, study tours and conferences, conducting research studies and preparing thematic papers.

IAPPD had effectively organized Eight Inter-university Debate Competitions for college students from 2005 to 2011 and 2024. These events saw enthusiastic participation from students representing different universities across India, who actively participated in debates and received commendation for their performances.

The upcoming event, the 9<sup>th</sup> Inter-university debate competition, continues this successful series. The topic for the National Level Debate Competition of this year is **"The Climate Crisis is posing a Threat to Human Health"** (जलवायु संकट मानव स्वास्थ्य के लिए खतरा बन रहा है) The university is expected to send one final winning team of two students, one speaking for the motion and one against the motion.

The expected date for the National Level Debate Competition will be February-March, 2025 at IAPPD Auditorium, 1/6, Siri Institutional Area, August Kranti Marg, New Delhi-110049. IAPPD will pay TA/DA to the participants.

The details (agenda/logistics) are communicated below:

Following are details for participation:-

**Inter-College Debate Competition:** IAPPD will pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rs.ten thousand only) to the universities to conduct Inter-College debate competition ; The break-up shown below:

First Prize - Rs.3000/-

Second Prize	-	Rs.2000/-
Third Prize	-	Rs.1500/-
Consolation Prize	-	Rs.1000/-
Contingency	-	Rs.2500/-

The above sum of Rs.2500/- will be paid to the universities by the IAPPD to meet other expenses, if any, relating to refreshments, payment to judges etc. Further it is expected that university would meet any other extra contingency expenses from its own sources.

**Inter-University Debate at the National Level:** IAPPD will award two sets of prizes. The first set of prize money will be given to the winning team's university and the second set is given to the individual winners. It is expected that Each team visiting Delhi will consist (2+1) - two participants one 'for' and one 'against' the motion and a team In-charge. The prize amount is as follows:-

**Team Prizes:**

1 <sup>st</sup> Prize to winner Team (University)	-	Rs.50,000/-
2 <sup>nd</sup> Prize to Runner up Team (University)	-	Rs.25,000/-

The Individual prizes would be awarded as under :

**Individual Prizes:**

First Prize	-	Rs.15,000/-
Second Prize	-	Rs.10,000/-
Third Prize	-	Rs.5,000/-
Consolation prizes (two students)	-	Rs.2,500/-

In addition, IAPPD will also award a Citation and a Trophy to the Winning team and also a Memento to Runner-up Team.

**T.A. Reimbursement**

1. IAPPD will also pay TA to participants and provide free reasonable board and lodging on twin sharing basis to out-station participants.
2. 3 Tier A.C. train travel/bus fare would be reimbursed on submission of tickets/proper receipt.
3. Team In-charge with outstation participants would be reimbursed 3-Tier A.C. train travel/bus fare on producing the ticket.
4. Extra expenses, if any, incurred by the student/Team In-charge will be considered as their 'Personal' expenses and no reimbursement will be made for the same by the IAPPD.

We shall be grateful, if you could kindly confirm your willingness by 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2024 to conduct these competitions.
